


# WEST VANCOUVER'S UPPER LANDS

February 2014

The District of West Vancouver is considering the future of the Upper Lands. This involves reviewing bylaws, policies, and programs outlined in the 2001 Upper Lands Study and the District's Official Community Plan. The review will help to determine what lands should be protected, what lands can be developed, uses of public land, and appropriate forms of development.

District Council has appointed a group of dedicated residents to the Upper Lands Working Group. Their role is to guide the process to involve the community and to make recommendations to Council.



## Quick Facts:

- The Upper Lands include 6,265 acres of undeveloped land.
- Most of the Upper Lands (72%) is above 1,200 feet in elevation. In general, lands above the 1,200 foot contour line are designated for limited use and recreation. Lands below 1,200 feet are designated Future Neighbourhood Areas.
- The District owns 56% of the Upper Lands, and 64% of the land above the 1,200 foot contour.
- British Pacific Properties owns 34% of the Upper Lands.
