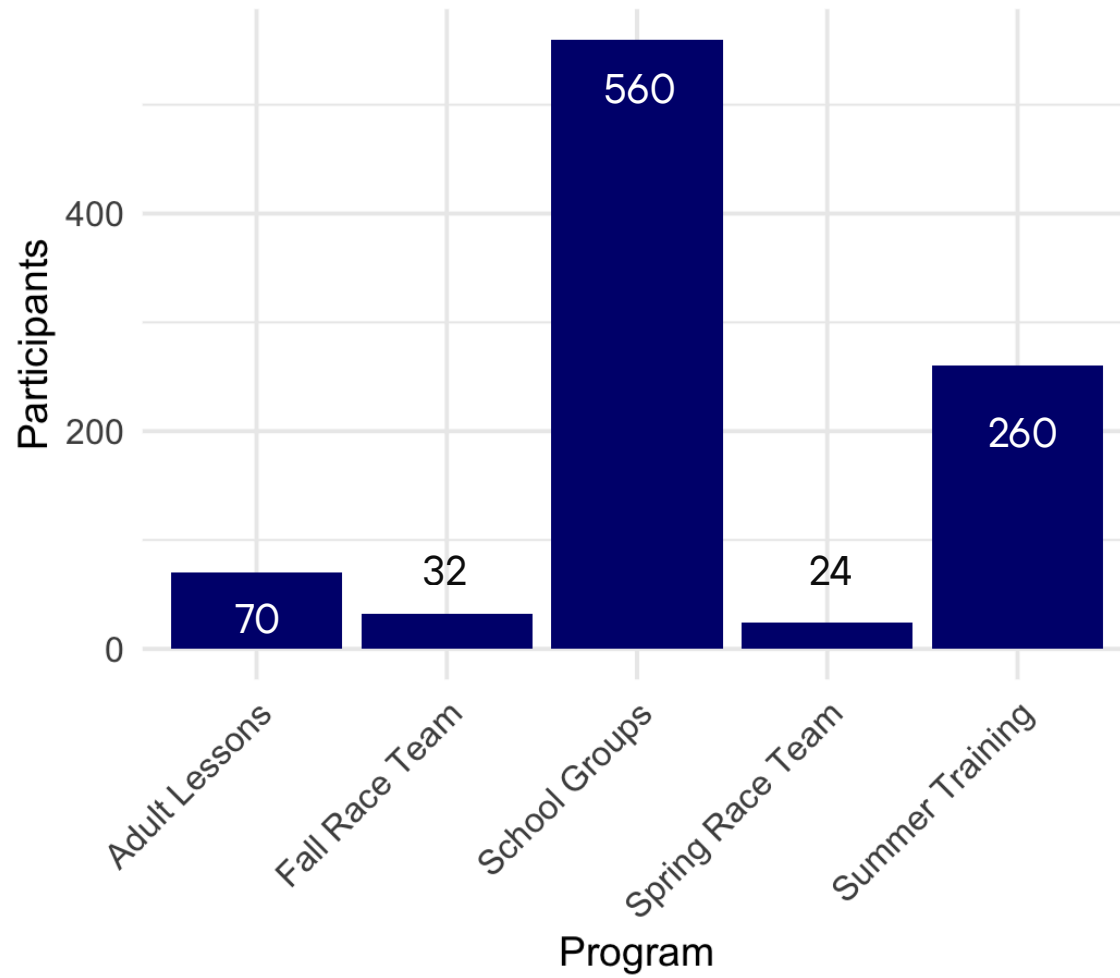
HSC Mission Statement:

Foiling Overview

- **WAZSP Race Team (Foiling)** *Fastest Growing Fleet in Canada*
 - Hollyburn has the largest fleet of WAZSP's in B.C. (9 boats). Designed for high-performance sailors. These sailors attend regattas throughout BC.



Summer Training Overview

- 260 participants ages 10-17
- We offer the Sail Canada CANSail 1-6 curriculum
- All levels run at full capacity and we maintain an extensive waitlist for these programs



Adult Lessons Overview

COOP members have access to **9 sailboats, 15 sea kayaks and 15 stand up paddleboards**



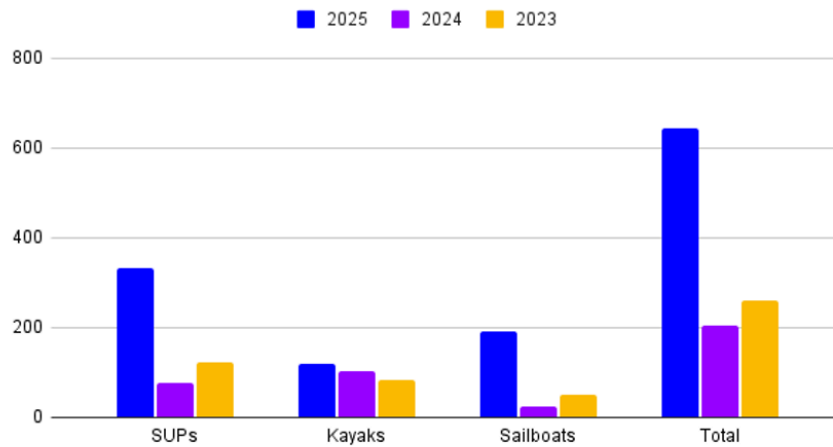
HSC CO-OP
