2024 West Vancouver Student Video Contest – Official Rules and Regulations

CONTEST THEME AND PURPOSE

The theme of the 2024 Student Video Contest is **Recycling in Parks.** The purpose of the contest is to get West Vancouver students and the broader community familiar with the District's new Parks Recycling Program and its importance to our community. This type of peer-to-peer learning encourages wider awareness and acceptance on issues that West Vancouver is addressing through our Parks Recycling Program and waste reduction work.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be West Vancouver residents and/or enrolled in Kindergarten to Grade 12 in a West Vancouver school.

ENTRY

All applicants <u>must register</u> **BEFORE** creating and submitting a video. If you do not register your video will not be considered. Once registration has been confirmed, videos must be submitted using the <u>online submission form</u>. Group work is permitted but the final video can only be submitted once. Registration is required for each student who appears in a video. All entries must be submitted by a parent/guardian.

DEADLINE

Entries must be received by Monday, April 15, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. PST.

FORMAT

All types of videos including live action, animation, Claymation, stop-motion, and music videos are accepted. Entries must be between 60 and 90 seconds long and posted on a publicly accessible YouTube channel. Entries that exceed this time and/or don't comply with YouTube's Terms of Service and Youtube's Community Guidelines will be disqualified. Entrants under 13 years of age are not allowed to have their own personal YouTube channel. In this case a consenting eligible YouTube channel can be used. Entrants understand and agree to YouTube storing their videos outside of Canada. All video content, including music, must be originally created. Check out the YouTube Audio Library for royalty-free production music and sound effects to use in your videos.

JUDGING

Videos will be judged based on whether they demonstrate creativity, an understanding of the theme, technical quality, and overall message. Videos should be regionally focused on West Vancouver and demonstrate the benefits and importance of the District's Parks Recycling Program.

The winning videos will be selected by a panel of judges and announced in May 2024.
