2025 funding recommendations - \$ 111,462

- reviewed 32 grant applications from 27 organizations
- total requests for funding - \$176,305
- funding requests ranged from \$500 to \$15,000
- three organizations new to the Program submitted applications



2025 Allocation of Funding

Community & Social Services

2025 funding recommendations - \$ 226,303

- reviewed 49 grant applications from 47 organizations
- total requests for funding - \$372,240
- funding requests ranged from \$500 to \$15,000
- 11 organizations new to the Program submitted applications
