Road Safety Programming Framework

Is a data driven, broad multi-disciplinary approach, working toward zero fatalities and serious injuries for all users of the road system.

Education (ICBC, VCH)

how to be safe at night, rules of the road

Engineering (Engineering & Transportation)

intersection safety, traffic calming measures

Enforcement (WVPD)

increased staffing, automated speed enforcement

Community Development (Planning)

driveway locations, adequate right of way for all users

Legislation (all levels of Government)

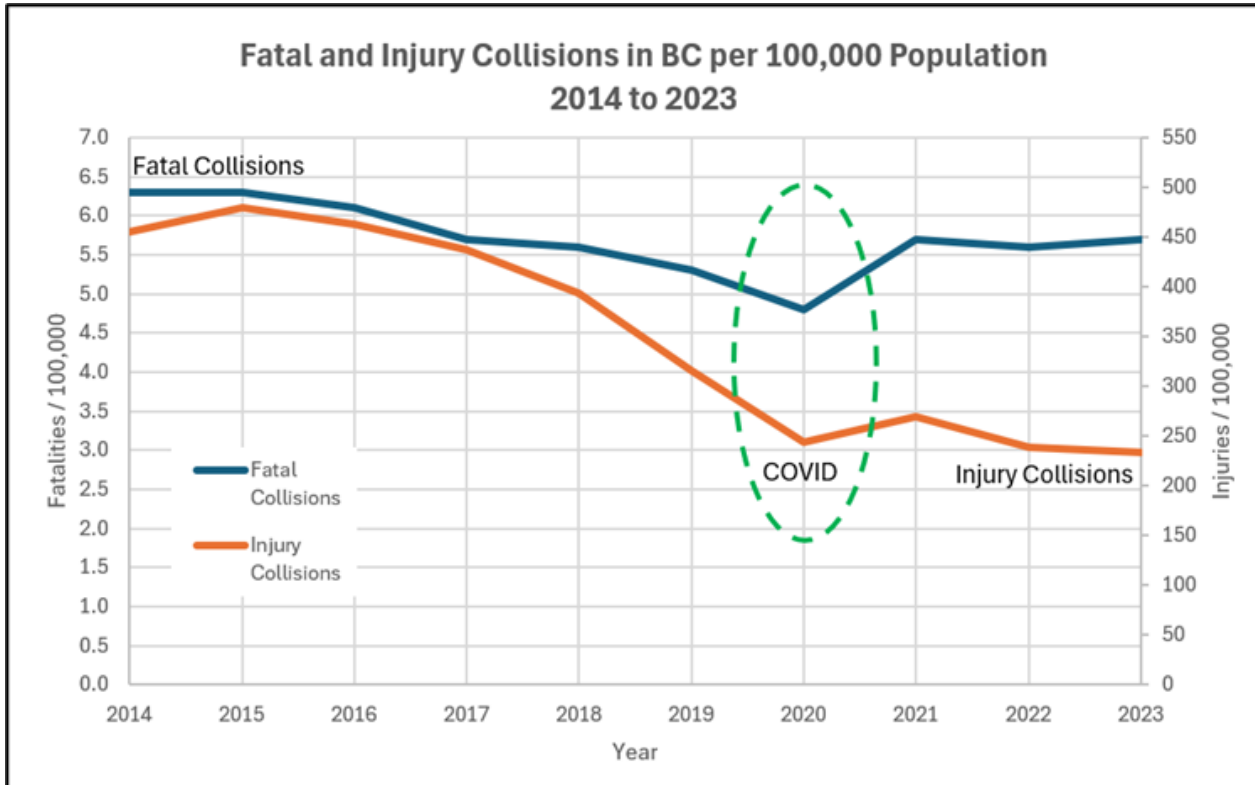
vehicle safety features, automatic enforcement

Vision Zero

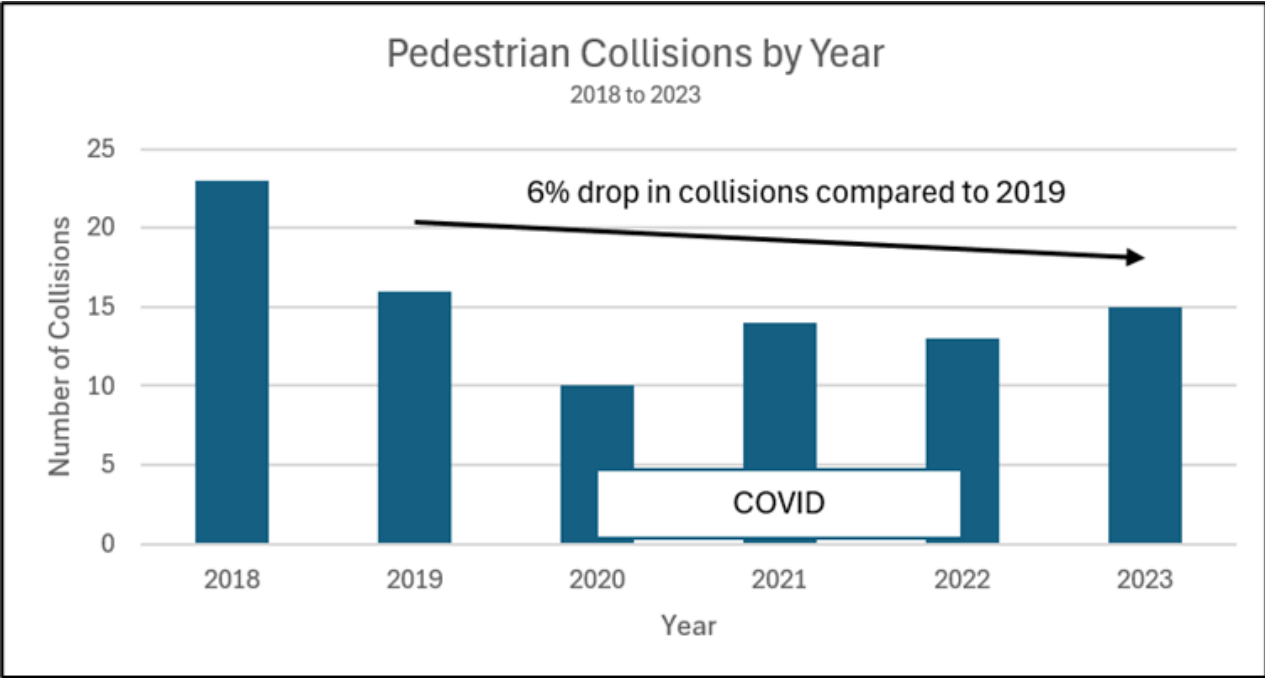
Safe Systems = Safe Mobility



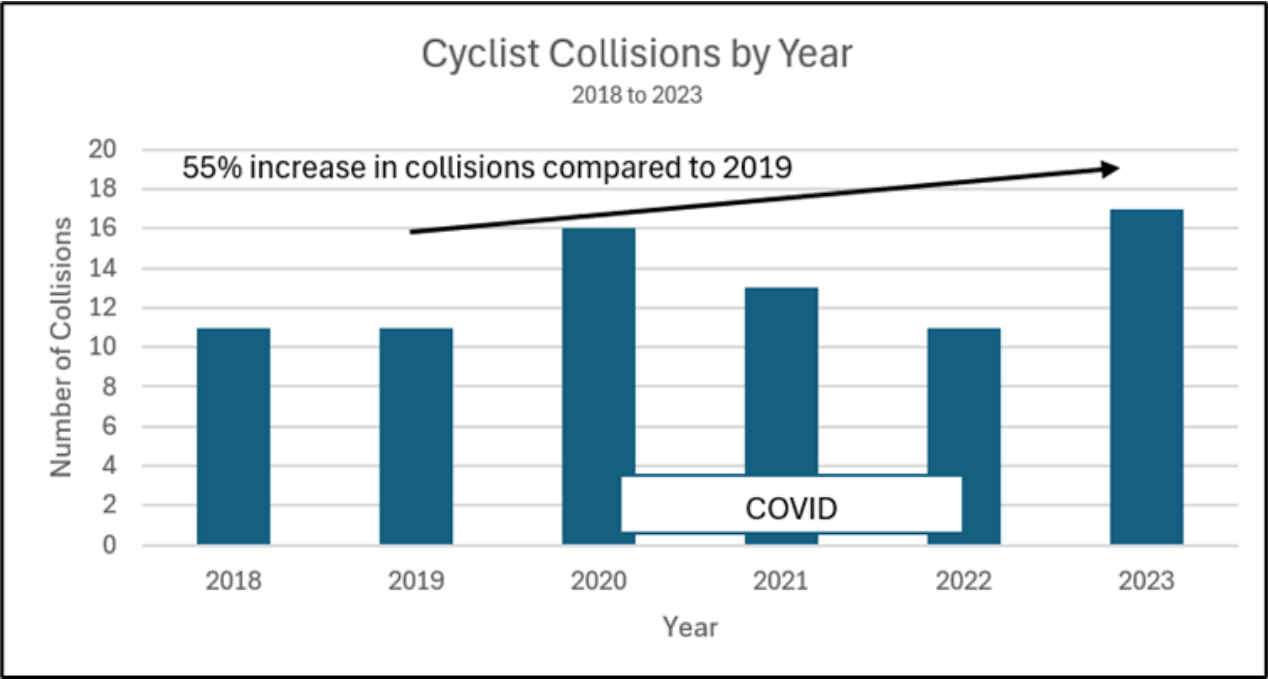
Collision Rates in British Columbia



Collision Rates in West Vancouver - Pedestrians

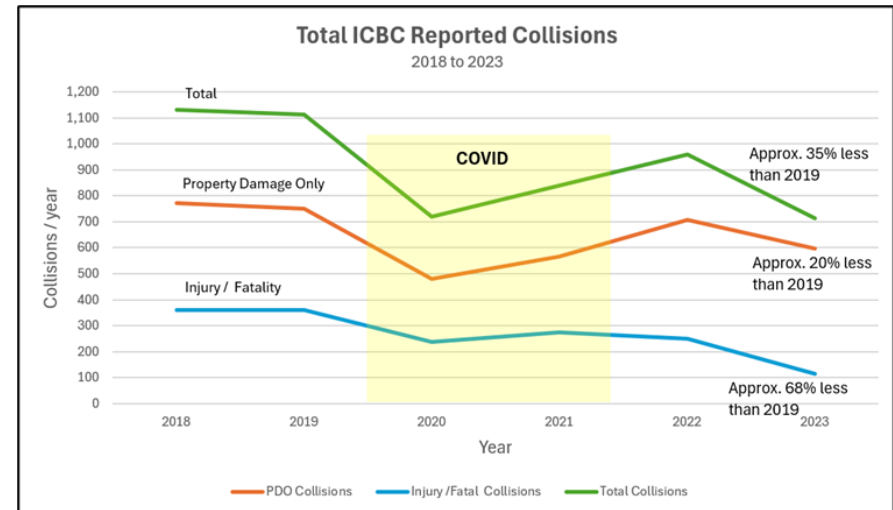


Collision Rates in West Vancouver - Cyclists
