Attendance to False Fire Alarms (subject to applicable taxes)	
Description	Fee
On the occurrence of a first false alarm, during any consecutive twelve month period, there will be a fee charged of:	Free
On the occurrence of a second false alarm, during any consecutive twelve month period, there will be a fee charged of:	\$200
On the occurrence of a third false alarm, during any consecutive twelve month period, there will be a fee charged of:	\$300
On the occurrence of a fourth false alarm, and for each subsequent false alarm, during any consecutive twelve month period, there will be a fee charged of:	\$400

Schedule C of Schedule 7 - Fire Protection and Emergency Response Charges

Fire Protection and Emergency Response Charges

(subject to applicable taxes)

Where one or more members of the Fire Department attends at any parcel of land to provide any service, or perform any function, which the Fire Department is authorized to provide or perform under any enactment, the occupier of that parcel, or, if there is no occupier, the owner of that parcel, shall pay to the District, within 30 days of receiving an invoice from the District, a service charge equal to the Extra Cost incurred by the District as a result of that attendance.

Where one or more members of the Fire Department attends at any incident on any highway to provide emergency assistance of any kind, the person to whom that assistance is provided shall pay to the District, within 30 days of receiving an invoice from the District, a service charge equal to the Extra Cost incurred by the District as a result of that attendance.

“Extra Cost” means any cost incurred by the District that would not have been incurred by the District but for an attendance referred to in this Schedule, including, without limitation, equipment rentals, overtime payments to officers or employees of the District and costs incurred for detection dog services for fire cause determination.
