5. Arts & Culture Strategy: Busking Bylaws and Home Based Business Regulations

S. Swan reported on his research into the busking bylaws in Edmonton, Alberta which hosts a large street performer's festival annually. Staff reported that the District of West Vancouver busking bylaw mainly relates to busking in parks. The committee could initiate discussion with District departments to determine if a change in bylaw is a desired direction. Any changes to bylaws must be approved by Council.

Members discussed the potential to approach Park Royal and the District's Events Department to see if pilot projects could be initiated at Park Royal and during festivals and special events. This would assist in determining the community's appetite for bylaw changes which would be a potential next step if the pilot projects are well received.

It was Moved and Seconded:

THAT S. Swan and staff meet with District events staff and P. Bowles meet with Park Royal in October and report back to the committee.

It is noted that S. Swan and B. Milley left the meeting at 3:33 p.m. due to technical connection issues which resulted in a loss of quorum. As quorum was lost, the meeting was adjourned at 3:35 p.m.


