1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:25 pm.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The Coastal Marine Management Plan Working Group (CMMPWG) approved the October 6, 2020 agenda as circulated.

3. COASTAL MARINE MANAGEMENT PLAN (CMMP) DRAFT REVIEW

G. Wharton led a discussion of the Public / Private section of the draft CMMP document. Working Group (WG) members discussed and suggested changes to the following:

- Key Issues 7.1.2, 7.1.3, 7.1.4, 7.1.5, 7.2.3, 7.2.4, 7.2.7, 7.2.8, 7.3.3, 7.3.6
- Move 7.2.6 to Coastal Dynamics section (tabled)
- Move 7.2.9 to Recommendations
- Public / Private Interface Subgroup will review 7.3.1 with legal counsel
- Interested in information from the Planning Department regarding 7.3.2
- Remove 7.3.5 and request KWL provide a list of responsibilities / issues
- Remove 7.3.8 and 7.3.9
- Move 7.3.10 to the beginning of the CMMP

The WG discussed and suggested changes to the Overview section of the CMMP draft document as follows:

- Page 1 – Introduction (“10 years”) – consider a greater time period
- Page 2 – add names of past members of the WG and acknowledge consultants’ contribution
- Page 4 – L. Williams (Chair) commented on the need for consultation with the Squamish Nation
- Section 2.1 – A. Nock to assist with visuals / maps

The WG suggested changes to pages 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 24 and recommended removing page 12.

Next Steps:

- Compile and incorporate feedback from the WG and share this feedback with the consultant (KWL), who will prepare the next draft.
- Staff will review the draft CMMP with other departments within the District.
- A verbal update will be given to the Community Engagement Committee.
- Public Consultation – timing depends on Covid-19, technology, etc.
- Public feedback will be incorporated into the final report, which will hopefully be available by January 2021.

The Planning Department would like to meet with the Working Group, to listen to the Working Group’s progress. Staff will provide WG members with possible dates.
