1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:10 pm.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The Coastal Marine Management Plan Working Group (CMMPWG) approved the

**4. REVIEW OF THE UPDATED DRAFT OF THE COASTAL MARINE
MANAGEMENT PLAN (CMMP)**

The Working Group reviewed each section of the draft CMMP. Several edits and
changes were discussed and noted by staff for incorporation into the final CMMP.

Items of note:

- L. Williams (Chair) will work with the consultant to review and revise the
Executive Summary.
- Section 2.2 Sea Level Rise and Storm Surge – discussion about information
in this section. C. Ambor (Parks Stewardship Manager) will confirm with the
consultant the scientific information referred to in this section.

- Section 3.3 – acknowledge newly recognized "Howe Sound Biosphere Region."
- Recommended Action A.2.3 – L. Williams will work with M. MacKinnon (Parks Environmental & Ecosystems Manager) to review and revise this section. L. Williams suggested a separate meeting with staff regarding the District's Archaeological Overview Assessment (AOA) process and Archaeological Impact Assessment (AIA) process.

5. NEXT STEPS

The Working Group agreed by consensus to changes to the draft CMMP that were discussed at this meeting. The final report to Council is tentatively scheduled for November 2021 (date to be determined), in conjunction with the Planning department's proposed Foreshore Development Permit Area (DPA).

L. Williams noted that the final document with changes discussed today will be shared with the Working Group via email.

L. Williams thanked the members of the Working Group for their hard work and dedication over the past several months, to produce the final CMMP. A. Banks (Senior Manager of Parks) thanked L. Williams and the Working Group for their hard work. Councillor Soprovich thanked Working Group members and encouraged staff to ensure recognition of Working Group members in the presentation to Council.
