**1. CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 pm.

**2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

The Coastal Marine Management Plan Working Group (CMMPWG) approved the June 1, 2021 agenda as circulated.

**3. CONTINUED REVIEW OF FINAL DRAFT OF THE COASTAL MARINE MANAGEMENT PLAN (CMMP)**

L. Williams (Chair) reported to the Working Group that she and District staff had a productive meeting with representatives from the Tsleil-Waututh Nation. All parties felt this was the beginning of a good relationship. Further to that meeting, some changes will be incorporated in the CMMP document, specifically more inclusive language. L. Williams will work with District staff to make the necessary changes.

The Working Group reviewed the final sections of the draft CMMP, including Section 4.1 (Built Infrastructure and Parks), Section 4.2 (Public-Private Interface), and Section 5 (Plan Implementation). Several edits and changes were discussed and noted by staff for incorporation into the draft CMMP.

Items of note:

- Objective 6.2.6 will be removed (outside the mandate of the CMMP Working Group).
- Objective 6.2.7 will be rewritten and moved to the Public-Private Interface section.

- Recommended Action 6.3.9 will be rewritten.
- Recommended Action 6.3.10 will be removed (not in the Terms of Reference).
- Recommended Action 6.3.13 will be removed.
- Recommended Action 6.3.15 will be rewritten and moved to the Public-Private Interface section.
- Introductory paragraph will be added at the beginning of the Public-Private Interface section.
- Recommended Action 7.3.1 will be rewritten and moved from short-term to medium-term.

#### 4. NEXT STEPS

The Working Group completed the review of the draft CMMP. Changes will be incorporated into the draft and forwarded to KWL. Given the very short time frame, it is anticipated that the CMMP will not be ready for a final report to Mayor and Council on June 28, 2021 and will be scheduled for the Fall.

This being the final meeting on drafting the CMMP, the Working Group members and staff congratulated L. Williams (Chair) on her exceptional leadership and perseverance to complete this project.


#### 6. PUBLIC QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS
