1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 pm.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The Coastal Marine Management Plan Working Group (CMMPWG) approved the April 13, 2021 agenda as circulated.

3. APPROVAL OF MEETING NOTES

The CMMPWG approved the February 17, 2021 meeting notes as circulated.

4. REVIEW OF PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT COMMENTS FOR THE DRAFT COASTAL MARINE MANAGEMENT PLAN (CMMP)

A. Mafi (Manager, Communications & Engagement) led a discussion regarding the results of the recent public engagement of the draft CMMP. In total, 70 comments were received from the public, and the Communications team have prepared a spreadsheet for summarizing the responses. There was a minor error in the survey; data from question #6 will be incorporated into data from question #7. Next steps are to organize the data, identify prominent themes, and summarize responses. A. Mafi will work with staff to provide direction, and L. Williams (Chair) will meet with

District staff to analyze the data. Relevant comments and themes will be incorporated into the CMMP as appropriate.

A. Mafi advised that a final report on the public engagement will be submitted to the Community Engagement Committee (CEC).

It was noted that some of the recommendations in the draft CMMP are also in the “Coastal Planning and Preparation of a Foreshore Development Permit Area” report to Council, which was recently presented to Council by the District’s Planning Department. The Public / Private Sub Group will meet to discuss the Foreshore DPA work being prepared by the Planning Department.

5. UPCOMING MEETING SCHEDULE

The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for April 27. The Working Group members were asked to submit any revised recommendations for review by April 20. The final draft CMMP will be reviewed in its entirety at the April 27 meeting, with the goal of submitting the final draft to KWL by the end of April.

There were no questions or comments from the public.

7. ADJOURNMENT

L. Williams (Chair) adjourned the CMMPWG meeting at 6:00 pm.
