## Dangerous Goods/ Compressed Gas Guidelines

The following require a Dangerous Goods/ Compressed Gas Permit

<b>Class 1 Explosives</b>	All
<b>Class 2.1 Flammable Gas (i.e. propane)</b>	For use in manufacturing, commercial processes, or storage of 10kg or greater than or equal to a K cylinder
<b>Class 2.2 Non Flammable Gas (i.e. CO2)</b>	All
<b>Class 2.3 Poisonous Gases</b>	All
<b>Class 2.4 Corrosive Gases</b>	All
<b>Class 3 Flammable Liquids</b>	Storage and use of more than 100L contained in original packaging and any quantity stored, used or deemed to raise the risk profile.
<b>Class 4 Flammable Solids</b>	Storage and use of more than 25kg contained in original packaging and any quantity stored, used or deemed to raise the risk profile.
<b>Class 5.1 Oxidizers</b>	Storage and use of more than 50kg contained in original packaging and any quantity stored, used or deemed to raise the risk profile.
<b>Class 5.2 Organic Peroxides</b>	Storage and use of more than 1kg contained in original packaging and any quantity stored, used or deemed to raise the risk profile.
<b>Class 6.1 Poisonous or Toxic Substances</b>	All
<b>Class 6.2 Infectious Substances/ Organisms</b>	All
<b>Class 7 Radioactive Materials</b>	All
<b>Class 8 Corrosive Liquid Acids &amp; Corrosives (i.e. mercury)</b>	All
<b>Waste Asbestos</b>	All
<b>Oil and Waste Oil</b>	Storage and use of more than 100L contained in original packaging and any quantity stored, used or deemed to raise the risk profile.
<b>Other Substances (i.e. new anti-freeze)</b>	Storage and use of more than 200L contained in original packaging and any quantity stored, used or deemed to raise the risk profile.
<b>Pesticides and Herbicides</b>	Storage and use of more than 1L contained in approved DOT original packaging and any quantity stored, used or deemed to raise the risk profile.
