

What is Happening?

The District of West Vancouver is preparing a conceptual design for the entry area, parking lot and washrooms in Lighthouse Park. The final conceptual design will recommend improvements to vehicle circulation, parking, washrooms, rainwater management, and environmental protection. The public input provided will allow the District to fine tune the concept plan and produce preliminary cost estimates that will be used for subsequent capital budget submissions.

The Process

The conceptual design process includes three stages of public engagement:

1. visioning stage (January 2014)
2. review of design options (Now)
3. communication of draft conceptual plan and preliminary cost estimates for capital budget submissions (Fall 2014)

Purpose of this Open House

The purpose of this session is to present design options based on the previous open house and to obtain your input to help guide the development of the final conceptual design.

We are providing information on:

- Potential materials for use in the design
- Two options for the parking / entry area
- Two options for the washrooms

We are requesting your input on:

- What materials do you think are most suitable for the park entry
- What options do you prefer for the parking / entry area and washrooms

Project Objectives

The following are some of the objectives used to guide the design:

- Respect the environment of the park including existing vegetation and the wetland downslope of the parking lot
- Manage rainwater and stormwater by maximizing infiltration as close to the source as possible
- Improve the circulation and efficiency of the parking lot
- Maximize the number of parking spaces without compromising existing vegetation
- Design to minimize maintenance costs
