

Altamont Park - Examples

PARK ELEMENTS:

This conceptual plan remakes Altamont Park as a mixed use and inviting place for the community to play and meet. It includes a renewed tennis court which is open to access on the net edge to a hardcourt for basketball, bike riding and games. The hard surfaces are connected with asphalt pathways to a sand play area which offers simple equipment focused on pre-schoolers. The activities of, swinging, sliding, spinning, balancing, bouncing and creative play are supported with a playhouse labyrinth, toddler swings, a teeter totter an embankment slide, a small spinner and a digger. A fallen hardwood tree and a net climber on the opened edges of the woodland area serves as starting points for nature play. Opportunities for sitting are incorporated throughout. Park vegetation is renewed with invasive and problem trees removed and a variety of new native and sustainable species planted to enhance biodiversity, bird habitat and enhanced use and enjoyment of the park.

FUNDING MODEL AND BUDGET:

The District will match all funds raised by the neighbourhood up to a maximum of \$100,000. With \$100,000 raised by the community the project budget would be \$200,000. This plan has been estimated at \$200,000.
