HORSESHOE BAY FERRY CONNECTIONS

Buses are generally scheduled to connect with ferries at Horseshoe Bay. However, it is not possible to guarantee this connection. Please allow yourself enough time for unexpected delays. Phone BC Ferries at 1-888-223-3779 to check departure times.

SEABUS

The SeaBus is a unique passenger-only ferry service connecting Vancouver with the North Shore via a scenic 12-minute harbour crossing. There are two terminals: Waterfront in downtown Vancouver, which connects with buses, SkyTrain and West Coast Express and Lonsdale Quay in North Vancouver, which connects with an extensive network of North Shore buses. Ferries and terminals are wheelchair-accessible. Bicycles are welcome.

SKYTRAIN

SkyTrain including the Expo, Millennium and Canada Lines, provides rapid transit service to 47 stations connecting with many Translink bus routes along the way. Trains operate approximately every 2-10 minutes. Blue Bus service connects downtown with the Expo/Millennium Lines at Granville and Burrard Stations and with the Canada Line at Vancouver City Centre station (Granville). All stations have elevators for those unable to use stairs and all trains are fully accessible.
