The nomination period begins on February 18, 2025, at 9 a.m. and ends on February 28, 2025, at 4 p.m. Nomination documents may only be filed with the chief election officer or deputy chief election officer during the nomination period:

- 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. February 18, 2025
- 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. February 19-21, 2025
- 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. February 24-27, 2025
- 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. February 28, 2025

The deadline for filing nomination documents is 4 p.m. on February 28, 2025.

For ease of scheduling nomination document filing, please contact Legislative Services (604-925-7004) to make an appointment during the nomination period.

Qualifications for office and nomination requirements are set out in the *Local Government Act* sections 81 to 83. Notice of the nomination period will be published in the local newspaper in January and February.

If you choose to have your solemn declarations taken by a lawyer or notary, the original signed nomination documents may be delivered to the chief election officer or deputy chief election officer by hand, by mail or by another delivery service. A copy of the nomination documents may be sent by email with originals to follow. Originals of all nomination documents previously delivered by email must be received by the chief election officer or deputy chief election officer **by 4:00 p.m. on March 7, 2025**; if the original signed documents are not received by the deadline then the person nominated is deemed to have withdrawn from being a candidate in the election.

Candidates' nomination documents will be available for public inspection on the District's website from the time of delivery until 30 days after the declaration of the official election results (General Local Elections Regulation Bylaw 4960, 2018).
