4. Annual Environment Committee Work Plan

The Committee Chair provided a presentation on the proposed Environment Committee Annual Work Plan for 2026 and received input.

- The process of proposing new initiatives to Council and determining success;
- Grant budgets and timelines for current projects funded by the Environmental Reserve Fund;
- Specifics of the new e-bike share program in West Vancouver; and
- The metrics of success for the District's climate action goals.

- Whether greenhouse gas emissions associated with cross-jurisdictional traffic are captured in reporting.
