**EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC**

2. RECOMMENDATION:

THAT in the public interest, members of the public be excluded from part of the May 13, 2024 special Council meeting on the basis of matters to be considered under the following section of the *Community Charter* and that notice be waived pursuant to section 127(4) of the *Community Charter*:

90. (1) A part of a council meeting may be closed to the public if the subject matter being considered relates to or is one or more of the following:

- (c) labour relations or other employee relations;
- (e) the acquisition, disposition or expropriation of land or improvements, if the council considers that disclosure could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality;
- (i) the receipt of advice that is subject to solicitor-client privilege, including communications necessary for that purpose;
- (j) information that is prohibited, or information that if it were presented in a document would be prohibited, from disclosure under section 21 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*; and
- (k) negotiations and related discussions respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public.

Purpose of meeting: labour relations; proposed provision of a municipal service; **business interests of a third party**; and land and legal matters.
