At 7 p.m. in the Council Chamber and via electronic communication facilities a public hearing regarding proposed: Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 4985, 2018, Amendment Bylaw No. 5301, 2024; and Zoning Bylaw No. 4662, 2010, Amendment Bylaw No. 5321, 2024 (Caulfeild Land Use Contract Area and Other Land Use Contract Sites) will be held. The regular Council meeting will commence in the Council Chamber and via electronic communication facilities immediately following the public hearing.

2. RECOMMENDATION:

THAT in the public interest, members of the public be excluded from part of the May 27, 2024 special Council meeting on the basis of matters to be considered under the following section of the *Community Charter*.

- 90. (1) A part of a council meeting may be closed to the public if the subject matter being considered relates to or is one or more of the following:
 - (a) personal information about an identifiable individual who holds or is being considered for a position as an officer, employee or agent of the municipality or another position appointed by the municipality;
 - (d) the security of the property of the municipality;
 - (e) the acquisition, disposition or expropriation of land or improvements, if the council considers that disclosure could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality;
 - (i) the receipt of advice that is subject to solicitor-client privilege, including communications necessary for that purpose; and
 - (k) negotiations and related discussions respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public.

Purpose of meeting: committee membership; the security of the property of the municipality; proposed provision of a municipal service; land and legal matters.
