

## **Major Infrastructure Projects**

#### Westmount Pump Station and Reservoir

- project estimate (in 2020 Dollars): \$15 million
  - portions of the projects may be funded by external contributions depending on future population servicing needs
- planning and design phase is currently in progress

#### 11 Street Pump Station


- awarded contract amount: \$5.35 million
  - \$1,300,000 external contributions
  - \$3,800,000 capital reserve
  - remainder from the infrastructure replacement funding from the utility rates
- anticipated substantial completion: End of 2025





## **Water Rates: Typical Impact**

#### **Single Family Residential Bill Impact**



- median single-family household will see an estimated annual increase of approximately \$34 over 2024 (4%)
- average multi-family unit will see an estimated annual increase of approximately \$12 over 2024 (4%)
- actual impact will vary based on metered usage
