Note: At 4 p.m. the special Council meeting will commence in open session in the Main Floor Conference Room and via electronic communication facilities and will be immediately followed by a motion to exclude the public in order to hold a closed session, pursuant to section 90 of the *Community Charter*. At 6 p.m. the regular Council meeting will commence in the Municipal Hall Council Chamber and via electronic communication facilities.

EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC

2. RECOMMENDATION:

THAT in the public interest, members of the public be excluded from part of the January 13, 2025 special Council meeting on the basis of matters to be considered under the following section of the *Community Charter*:

- 90. (1) A part of a council meeting may be closed to the public if the subject matter being considered relates to or is one or more of the following:
 - (a) personal information about an identifiable individual who holds or is being considered for a position as an officer, employee or agent of the municipality or another position appointed by the municipality;
 - (e) the acquisition, disposition or expropriation of land or improvements, if the council considers that disclosure could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality;
 - (i) the receipt of advice that is subject to solicitor-client privilege, including communications necessary for that purpose;
 - (k) negotiations and related discussions respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public; and
- 90. (2) A part of a council meeting must be closed to the public if the subject matter being considered relates to one or more of the following:
 - (b) the consideration of information received and held in confidence relating to negotiations between the municipality and a provincial government or the federal government or both, or between a provincial government or the federal government or both and a third party.

Purpose of meeting: committee membership; proposed provision of a municipal service; intergovernmental negotiations; and land and legal matters.

3. Adjournment of January 13, 2025 Special Council Meeting
