EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC

2. RECOMMENDATION:

THAT in the public interest, members of the public be excluded from part of the June 8, 2026 special Council meeting on the basis of matters to be considered under the following section of the *Community Charter*:

90. (1) A part of a council meeting may be closed to the public if the subject matter being considered relates to or is one or more of the following:

- (e) the acquisition, disposition or expropriation of land or improvements, if the council considers that disclosure could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality;
- (k) negotiations and related discussions respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public; and
- (l) discussions with municipal officers and employees respecting municipal objectives, measures and progress reports for the purposes of preparing an annual report under section 98 [*annual municipal report*].

90. (2) A part of a council meeting must be closed to the public if the subject matter being considered relates to one or more of the following:

- (b) the consideration of information received and held in confidence relating to negotiations between the municipality and a provincial government or the federal government or both, or between a provincial government or the federal government or both and a third party.

Purpose of meeting: proposed provision of a municipal service; municipal objectives and measures; intergovernmental negotiations; and land matters.

3. **Adjournment of June 8, 2026 Special Council Meeting**

Mayor Sager will adjourn the June 8, 2026 special Council meeting (open session).

Council will then proceed with the closed session.
