# **Appointment of Bylaw Enforcement Officers Bylaw No. 4834, 2015**

A bylaw to authorize the appointment of officers and employees to enforce municipal bylaws

Previous amendments: *Amendment Bylaw 5163*.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of West Vancouver deems it expedient to establish positions and to delegate bylaw enforcement authority to those positions;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the District of West Vancouver enacts as follows:

## **Part 1 Citation**

- 1.1 This bylaw may be cited as Appointment of Bylaw Enforcement Officers Bylaw No. 4834, 2015.

## **Part 2 Severability**

- 2.1 If a portion of this bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of this bylaw is deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.

## **Part 3 Interpretation**

- 3.1 For certainty, nothing in this bylaw shall be construed as repealing the authority to enforce a bylaw granted in an enactment that is not listed herein.

## **Part 4 Authority to Appoint**

- 4.1 The following positions are established: Bylaw Enforcement Officers, Senior Bylaw Enforcement Officers, Licence Inspectors, Manager of Bylaw

& Licensing Services, Building Inspectors, Electrical Inspectors, Director of Planning, Lands and Permits, Manager of Community Planning, Manager of Development Planning, Environmental Health Officers, Medical Health Officers, Environmental Protection Officers, Manager of Development Engineering, Development Services Engineer, Land Development Technician, Manager of Engineering Services, Manager of Roads and Transportation, Manager of Utilities, Municipal Engineer, Parks Supervisor, Manager of Parks, West Vancouver Fire Inspectors, Fire Officers and Fire Prevention Officers. The Council or Chief Administrative Officer of the District may, from time to time, appoint individuals to these positions or to act in the place of persons in these positions.

## **Part 5 Bylaw Enforcement Officers, Senior Bylaw Enforcement Officers, Licence Inspectors and Manager of Bylaw & Licensing Services – Authority to Enforce**

## Part 15 Ticketing Powers

- 15.1 Each person who is authorized under this bylaw to enforce a listed District bylaw also has the power to lay an information under that bylaw by means of a municipal ticket information under section 264 of the *Community Charter*.

## Part 16 Proviso

- 16.1 Nothing in this bylaw imposes a duty on an officer or employee of the District or a West Vancouver Police Officer to administer or enforce the provisions of any bylaw.
