Directories were compiled by private firms for commercial sale, and include business and residential listings. Listings may include residents' names, spouse names, occupation, and street address.

Tax Assessment Rolls (1912 to 1974):

These are the official records of property values and taxes owed, dating to the incorporation of the municipality in 1912. The information found in the registers can be used to determine when a house was built, the size and value of the land and structure, and the names of the property owners. To access this information, you will need the property's legal address (District Lot, Block and Lot number). Person-to-person

- Discover and interview previous owners/occupants
- Talk to your neighbours and long-time residents
- Go to local history presentations of interest

The house itself

- Look for newspapers in pocket doors, wall lining, dates written under wallpaper during renovations photograph and document!
- Look for plaques or other mementos in attic and basement rafters
- Research the style of house, the building materials, its fixtures etc.

Related topics to research

Research the history of your area, to provide general background – you may
often serendipitously find references to your house and past owners. Topics
include significant businesses and past residents of local renown.
