- You must meet the requirements in this section in order to register as a Non-Resident Property Elector in West Vancouver.

- 5. This is information required pursuant to the *Local Government Act*, section 70(1)(b).
- 6. Print the street address or legal description of the applicant's real property for which the applicant is registering.
- 7. The elector *must* indicate Yes or No whether the property is jointly owned.
- This information is to identify persons who have had a name change since the last election and who were on the list of electors.
