

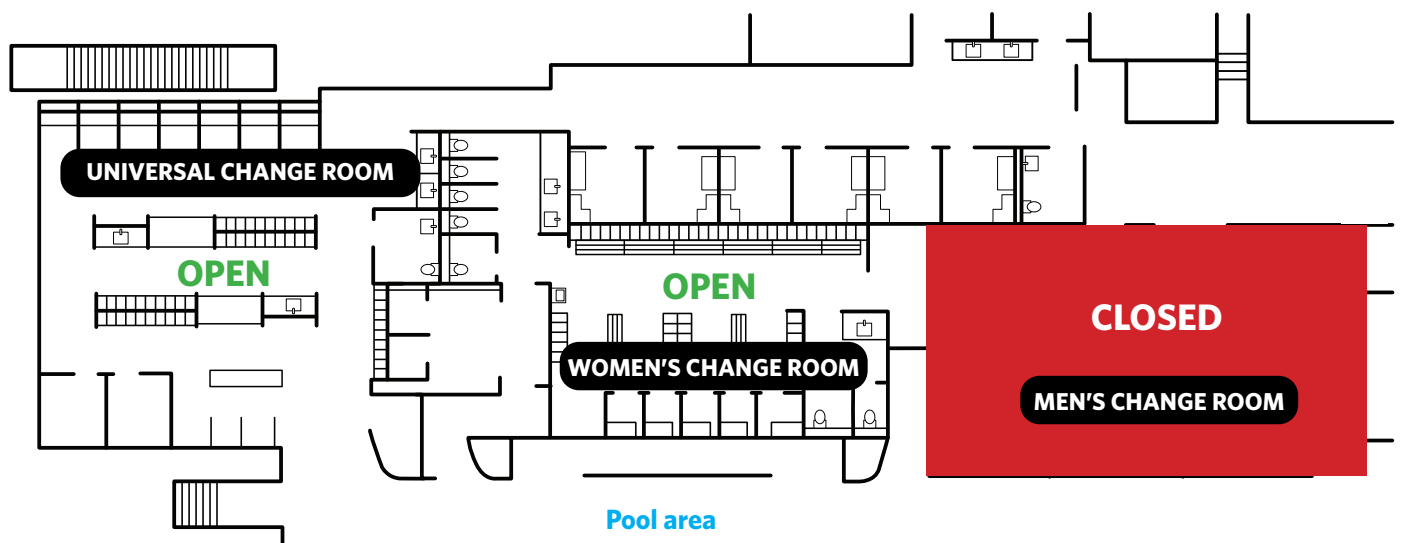

Frequently Asked Questions

What's happening at the Aquatic Centre?

The Universal Change Room will be partially closed for wall repairs from April 7 to May 3. During construction, the middle section of the Universal Change Room and the passway to the pool deck area will be temporarily closed. Two sections for Universal Change Room (pictured below) and the Men's and Women's Change Rooms will remain open. Alternate access to the pool deck and west section of the Universal Change Room will be available through the men's and women's change rooms.

After wall repairs are complete, locker upgrades will take place from **May to June**, in *all change rooms*—starting with the Universal Change Room—and will require a three-to-four-day closure of each change room:

Universal Change Room:

Now open.

Women's Change Room:

Now open.

Men's Change Room:

Closed—reopening delayed. Check back for updates.

The above dates subject to change.

What kind of lockers will be installed?

Spectrum Solid Phenolic lockers with standard padlock hasp (pictured below).



Will there be a cost to use the lockers?

Use of the lockers will be free of charge; however, patrons will need to bring their own padlock or purchase one from the front desk.

Can I store my items overnight?

No, all items must be removed at the end of each pool visit. Locks will be cut and items removed from any lockers that have not been vacated by the end of the night.

Will there be noise?

Yes, please expect construction noise (demolition, cutting, sanding, drilling, fastening, etc.) for the duration of this project.
